ISPM 15 Export Compliance Checklist — Heat Treated Wooden Packaging Material (Gauteng, South Africa)

Use this checklist to ensure your wooden packaging meets international phytosanitary requirements before exporting.

. Packaging Identification	
Confirm that your packaging is made from solid wood thicker than 6 mm (pallets, crate boxes, dunnage, skids).	es,
Exclude processed wood products (plywood, MDF, chipboard) — they are exempt.	
. Treatment Requirements	
 Ensure all wood has been heat treated (HT) to ISPM 15 standards: Core temperature ≥ 56°C for 30 minutes 	
Verify the treatment was performed by a registered or approved facility . Keep the heat treatment certificate or invoice for records.	
s. ISPM 15 Marking	
Check that each pallet, crate or dunnage piece is clearly stamped with the ISPM 15 ma ncluding: • IPPC symbol • Country code (ZA)	ark,
Unique treatment provider code Treatment type (HT)	
Ensure the stamp is visible and permanent (burned, branded, or printed). Reject packaging with missing, blurred, or fake markings.	
. Documentation & Recordkeeping	
Keep copies of treatment certificates and supplier invoices . Store records for each export consignment .	
File documentation with your export compliance or logistics officer .	
. Destination Country Check	
Verify import requirements for your destination country (some require KD or special leclarations).	
Ensure fumigation certificates if the importing country requests MB (methyl bromide). Confirm all paperwork is attached for customs inspection.	

6. Supplier Verification
□ Source pallets, crates and dunnage from registered ISPM 15 suppliers (like Arminel
Industries).
\square Confirm the supplier can provide HT and IPPC marking documentation.
\square Request batch numbers for traceability.
7. Final Inspection Before Dispatch
7. Final Inspection Before Dispatch Usually inspect pallets and crates for infestation, mold, or moisture.

□ Visually inspect pallets and crates for infestation, mold, or moisture .

Failure to meet ISPM 15 standards may lead to shipment rejection, quarantine, or destruction at the destination port.
